Position Summary

The HCCN works collaboratively with the RN and other interdisciplinary team members including Health Care Aids to deliver care in clinic and client's home. The Licensed Practical Nurse's scope of practice dictates nursing care that is within their knowledge and ability.

Hours per week: Negotiable – Full time 35 hours week/ part time 21 hours week (hours negotiable)
